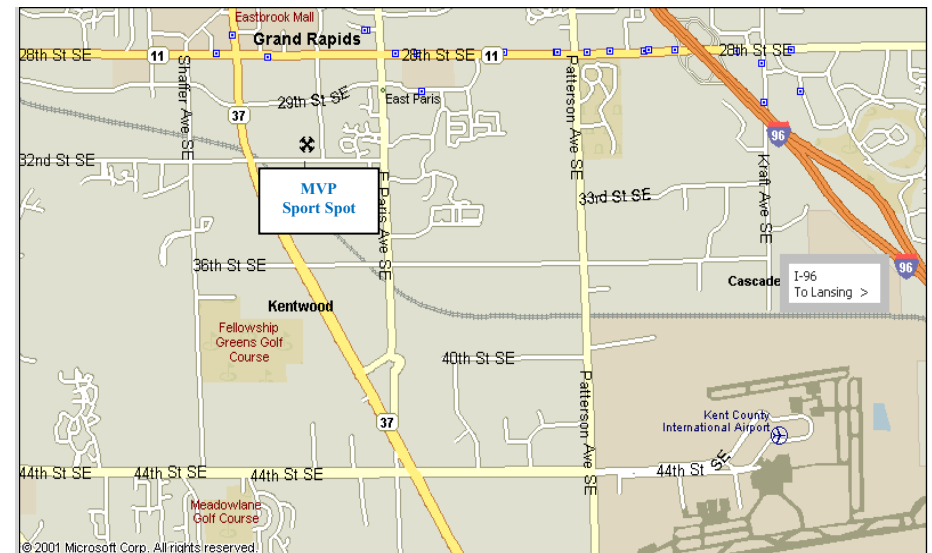

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- **Obedience 1 and Obedience 2 to run concurrently. Rally Trial 2 to follow Rally Trial 1. Rally 2 will start when Utility Ring is done.**
- The club may cancel this event due to extreme weather conditions.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- A Wait List will be established to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to the event closing date.
- Jump Heights – include jump height on entry form. For those classes with a jump, dogs will be judged in ascending jump height order
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the show committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Refunds minus \$10/day administrative fees will be given to bitches in season and all dogs that can't compete due to injury upon receipt of an excuse from a licensed veterinarian written on his/her letterhead. All refund requests must be received within 2 weeks of end of trial.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 service charge for returned checks. Overpayments of less than \$10 will be considered a donation to the club and will not be returned.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely.
- Dogs must be on leash AT ALL TIMES except when in the ring or in warm up areas.

TRIAL ENTRY

MAIL all entries with fees to the Trial Secretary. Express Mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at trial secretary's address without recipient's signature. TELEPHONE, FAXED, INCOMPLETE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES will not be accepted. ENTRY FEES

Entry fees are per event number. First entry - \$30, Second entry of the same dog, same event number, \$23. Obedience and Rally are separate trials. Junior entry fees are \$20 for those juniors under 18 as of the date of the trial with an AKC Junior Handler number.

MIXED BREED ENTRIES

TRANSFER (Formerly Move-ups) CONDITIONS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an AKC title. Move ups will be allowed up to ½ hour prior to the start of the trials each day. Transfers allowed from Rally Trial 1 to Trials 2 if received ½ hour before the start of class in Trial 2.
